



EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

The MRFA&E has developed outreach campaigns to address impaired riding, motorist awareness, and motorcycling skills:

The 3Rs: designed to teach motorcyclist there are many forms of impairment and the horrific consequences of riding impaired.

Share The Road: designed to help motor vehicle operators become more aware of motorcyclists. This classroom presentation is offered at safety workshops, schools, industry safety meetings and driver education classes.

SMART Trainer: a riding simulator that puts the rider in a "virtual" on-road motorcycling world where he/she controls a motorcycle while being subjected to hazards and obstacles encountered in everyday riding.

MRFA&E also offers training and riding demonstrations on specific riding skills and conducts seminars to train presenters for these programs.



YOUNG ACTIVIST SCHOLARSHIPS

The MRFA&E recognizes and encourages young motorcyclists who get involved in the sport and lifestyle of riding and in the education of other motorcyclists.


